3rd Annual Historical Scholarship Program



Eligibility:

1. Students should be graduating seniors with at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale or equivalent GPA.
2. Students must be pursuing a degree or certificate at an accredited institution of higher education (i.e. Junior College, Community College, Technical College, College, University or Trade School)
3. Students must be involved in school and/or community activities. (i.e. FFA, 4-H, Ecology Club, Scouting, Science Club, Student Council, Leo Club, Leadership Council, etc.)
4. Students must submit a 500-800 word essay exhibiting knowledge of and interest in the history and culture of Native and Early Americans during the historical period ranging from 1640-1840.
5. A letter of recommendation must be attached to the application from a teacher, mentor or other community leader.
6. Applications must be submitted to the EMPO President Alan Superko Jr. at 241 Doolittle Hill Rd, Laceyville, PA 18623 - postmarked no later than May 1st, 2020.

Award:

If selected, the recipient will receive a one-time award of \$1,000. One award will be granted in 2020.

Selection will be made from all eligible applicants by the EMPO Scholarship Committee based on the most outstanding essay as determined by committee majority.

Winner will be announced on May 15th, winners will be notified by phone and mail.

Disbursement of funds:

Disbursement will be made directly to the institute of higher education. EMPO will work with the student and the institute's financial aid officer to determine the most appropriate payee for the award.

Recipients have no obligation to EMPO.

All applicants agree to the decision as final.

Award is contingent on the student completing their senior year in good standing with both their school and their community and after successfully completing the first semester of higher education. EMPO and the scholarship committee reserve the right to apply the award to subsequent scholarships if no suitable applications are received for 2020.
